Project Information



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1. ACCESS TO THE PLATFORM

- **URL:** <https://learning.efficient2parenting.eu/?redirect=0>
- **Login:**
 - Click on the “Login” button in the top right corner.
 - Enter your username and password.
 - If you don’t have an account, click on “Create new account” or contact the administrator for support.

2. COURSE LANGUAGE SELECTION

Home Page



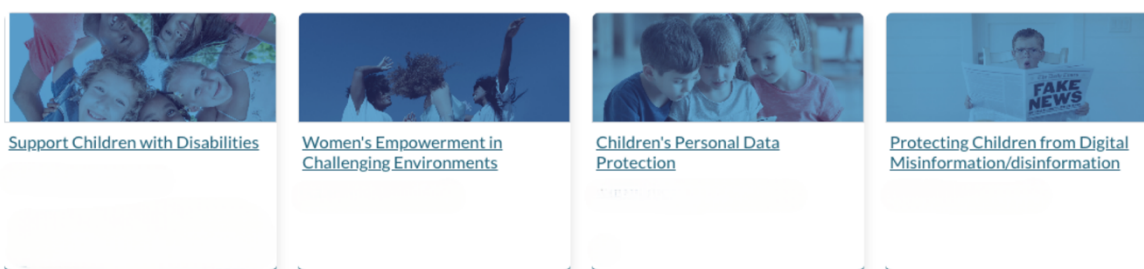
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- The main page displays a list of available courses.

Course Organization

The EP2 platform offers **four main courses**, each focusing on a key area of child development, digital safety, and gender equality:



- **Support Children with Disabilities**
Supporting children with disabilities through inclusive and tailored approaches.
- **Women's Empowerment in Challenging Environments**
Promoting women's empowerment in difficult contexts, addressing education, participation, and well-being.
- **Children's Personal Data Protection**
Key principles for protecting children's personal data in digital and educational environments.
- **Protecting Children from Digital Misinformation/disinformation**
How to teach critical thinking to protect children from misinformation online.

Each course is structured into:

- **Introduction** – Summary of the module's objectives and content.
- **Lessons with theory and practice** – Educational materials, key concepts and activities designed to apply the acquired knowledge.
- **Resources** – Additional material to support the learning process.

4. NAVIGATING WITHIN A COURSE



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1. Select the course from the homepage.
2. Review the **Introduction** section for a detailed overview of what you'll learn.
3. Navigate through the lessons using the "Next" and "Previous" buttons or the sidebar menu.
4. Complete the activities by following the provided instructions.

5. USE OF ADDITIONAL RESOURCES

- **File downloads:** PDF, Word, or other file formats are available for download.
- **External links:** Some resources may redirect you to external websites. Open them in a new tab to avoid losing your progress.
- **Videos:** Click the "Play" button to watch embedded videos directly on the platform.

2. Carefully read all instructions before starting.
3. Once finished, click "Submit" to record your responses.
